Additional Information:

This device is a three-pole circuit breaker which incorporates ground fault sensing and relaying equipment with a 30 mA or 100mA trip level and is rated 15, 20, 30 A, 40 A and 50 A, 208Y/120 VAC & 240 VAC, 60 Hz.

Catalog number designation EPD has a ground fault threshold of 30mA
Catalog number designation EPE has a ground fault threshold of 100mA

There circuit breakers maybe accessorized with an Auxiliary Switch, contact type A or B, or an Alarm Switch.
